

Parking Changes Continue at Hospital

Parking lots opening and closing

Last month, we reported that a new parking lot (see #1 on map) would open and another would close (see # 2). This was delayed because of the ice storm. The current lot has been partially closed and the rest of the lot should close by early February. Within the same timeframe, the new lot will open.

When this happens, patients will notice the following:

- There will be an overall gain of about 20 parking spaces



- Lights from the current lot (#2) will be temporarily moved to the new lot (#1) for the winter
- In the spring, the new lot will be finalized with islands, plantings and permanent lights
- The new lot is slightly lower than the adjacent lot. This difference guides water run-off from the new lot into the new detention pond (see #3).

Other Updates

- The main entrance to the hospital campus will remain the same throughout the winter.

Roundabout construction will resume in the spring.

- Perimeter road construction (see #4 & 5 on map) will continue throughout the winter. The road will remain closed.
- Half of the foundation for the generator building (see #6 on map) has been poured. It should be finalized by early February.
