### Web pages launched with more expansion info

This month, we have two exciting topics to share with the community – construction at the current street entrance is continuing and we have dedicated new pages on our web site about the expansion project. Let's start with the entrance and safety.

#### Driving Safely on Hospital Roads

Because of increased construction at and near the entrance and hospital roads, **we are reminding the public and MCH employees to remain alert and to drive slowly and carefully on the hospital grounds. Please avoid tailgating cars and construction vehicles.**

Just last week, the MCH road sign was temporarily moved to the right of the entrance, and the stone island that supported the sign was removed. Please note that the plaque on the island has been saved and will be rededicated at a later date.

Over the next four to eight weeks, there will be more changes requiring alert and safe driving including the following:

- MCH will connect to the town water main near the entrance and prepare the ground to bring



additional water lines on the hospital campus

- Rotary construction within the MCH grounds will continue
- Parking lot and perimeter road construction will continue

#### Navigating the Campus Safely

In order to help patients and visitors safely find their way on campus, new striping has been painted on the road.

Additional directional signs will help direct traffic and flagmen will be present when needed. Please follow all directional striping and signs.
