

Hospital and Town Road Construction Continues Through the Spring

Over the next month, construction at the MCH campus and on the Town's connector road will continue at the same pace it has for the past four weeks.



Roundabout Construction at Current Street Entrance

- The roundabout at the hospital's current street entrance is beginning to visibly take shape. (See #1 on map)
- Crews will continue working on the roundabout over the next month.
- We hope to open the roundabout and adjoining perimeter road (See #2 on map) on the north side of the campus in late spring and will keep you informed as this project progresses.

Please remain alert and drive slowly and carefully on the hospital grounds.

Parking Lots at MCH

- Parking lots will remain the same for the next month.
- In May and June, portions of some lots will temporarily close and others will open.
- Our May update will outline those changes so that you can plan accordingly.

Town Connector Road

- The roadway has been cleared. (See #3 on map)
- Over the next month, construction crews will develop the layout of the roundabout (See #4 on map) and new access at Old Street Road.

The connector road is intended to improve access to the hospital for patients and emergency vehicles. It will also reduce traffic on Old Street Road and Sand Hill Road as well as congestion at the intersection of Route 202, 136 and Old Street Road. The Town is currently on schedule to complete this project in the fall.
