

Parmelee Entrance at Hospital Closes July 1

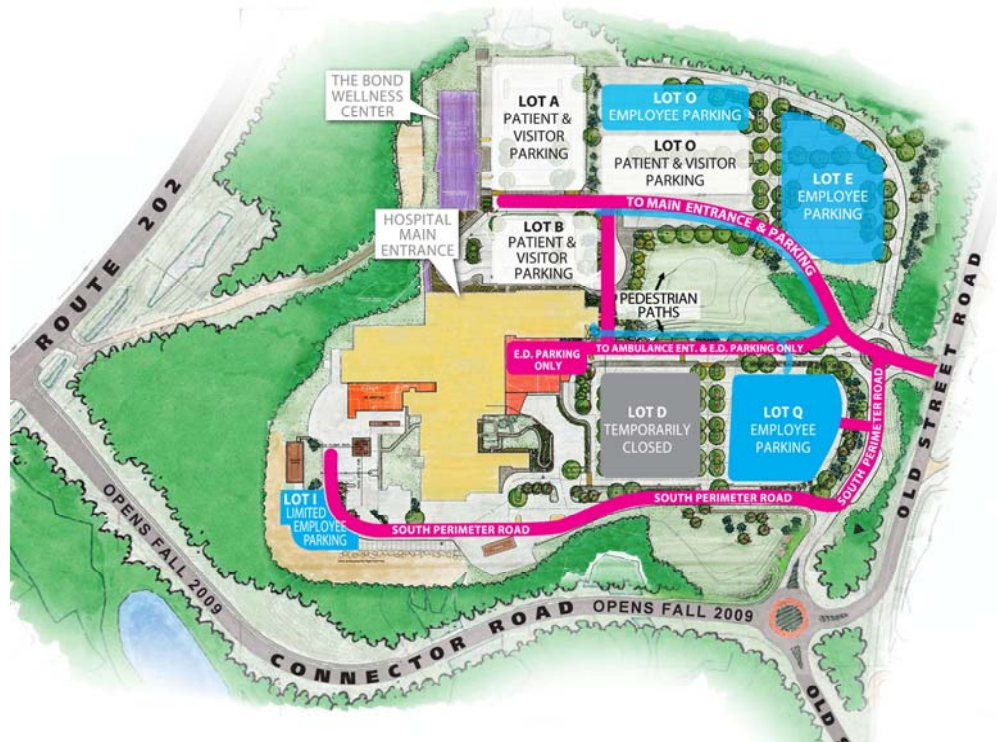
Visitors must use main hospital entrance for offices and conference rooms in Parmelee Building

In order to prepare the grounds for MCH's new Emergency Department, the entrance to the Parmelee Building and the parking lots directly in front of that building will close on July 1. This closure will affect parking and pedestrian access to the administration offices, human resources and Conference Rooms 3-5.

Emergency Department Parking

The parking spaces immediately outside of the Emergency Department doors will remain open for ED patients and emergency vehicles only.

To access this area, take your second left after entering the hospital campus from Old Street Road and follow directly to the ED.



Accessing the Parmelee Building

Patients and visitors who want to access Human Resources, Hospital Administration and Conference Rooms 3-5 should:

- Enter through the hospital main entrance or Medical Arts Building
- Take a map at the entrance and walk to the elevator next to Day Surgery
- Take the elevator to the second floor of the hospital building
- Follow the signs on the walls to the Parmelee building offices

You may also speak to the receptionist at the main entrance for instructions.

- **Patient parking** remains the same in lots A, B, and O
- **Staff parking** is in lots O, E, I and the new lot Q
- **Emergency department parking** is limited to the area directly in front of the ED
