

Roadwork Nears Completion New access to Rotary

Main Campus Rotary gains new access to Employee Lot O. Please read below for more details.

Roadwork Nears Completion
Construction of roadways in and around the campus is nearing completion with some additional work scheduled to be completed this coming spring in front of the Medical Arts Building.

New Access Road opens from Main Campus

Rotary (See #1 on map)

Beginning Monday 12/14/09, traffic entering the Main Campus Rotary will have the option of accessing Employee Lot O directly via a newly paved extension. Next spring, this roadway will be further extended to provide direct access to the new Emergency Care Entrance.

Emergency Department Construction Begins

Work continues alongside the Medical Arts building in preparation for the new Sarah Hogate Emergency Department. Currently, construction crews are installing water lines to supply the new building's needs. On Friday, December 18th, testing will be completed on these new lines and a formal 'cut-over' process will occur. At that point, the water supplies for the Medical Arts Building and our



current Emergency Department will be re-routed, allowing for removal of the old lines and construction of the new foundation to continue. Currently, work is also underway completing underground drainage lines for the new building's foundation. Construction of the actual foundation for the building is scheduled to start in a few weeks in early January.

Surgical Suite Expansion

Construction at the site of our future Surgical Suite is well underway. This area was formerly occupied by the MRI pad. Currently, water lines are being rerouted through this area that will supply the new building. Following completion of these lines, construction is scheduled to begin on the new foundation.

Helipad Relocation

The MCH helipad is now located in the former NEBS parking lot with ambulance service supporting transitional transportation as needed. Emergency medical responders and dispatchers were notified through a formal communication process in preparation for the move.
