Rotary to be Paved (See #1 on map)

Paving will occur on the rotary adjacent to the Main Campus entrance within the next 5-7 days. Following that, the rotary will remain closed for 2 weeks. Traffic entering the facility will then be directed through the rotary. We will provide additional information on new traffic patterns in 2 weeks.

Employee Parking Increasing: Lot D (See #2 on map)

In 2 weeks, 50% of Lot D will reopen, creating 60 new parking spaces that will be temporarily used for employee parking.

Lot O - New Islands (See #4 on map)

After Lot D opens, new traffic islands will be installed. This will result in the loss of several parking places.

Dear Liz

With the summer site-preparation phase in full swing, changes will continue to happen at an accelerated pace in August. New areas of parking will begin to appear as grading and paving continues. Access to the parking lot behind the cafe will be reduced to one lane to permit new utility lines to the Generator building. Please read on for more details.

Timeline: Next 2 Weeks

- Rotary to be paved (will remain closed)
- Half of Lot D to open for employee parking
- Single lane access to Lot I due to sewer lines construction.
- Temporary ED entrance to be built

Timeline: Next 3-8 Weeks

- Opening of temporary ED entrance
- Opening of rotary for traffic
- Changes to Main Campus traffic pattern

Temporary Ambulance Entrance: Exterior Changes (See #3 on Map)

A 100-foot ramp will be installed within the next 2 weeks. This ramp will provide temporary access for ambulance arrivals for several months while the new ED building is being constructed. It will be located directly to the left of the current ED entrance. The large retaining wall in front of the ED entrance will be removed in the next 2 weeks to allow for easier access to the new ED entrance. Inside, this entrance will connect at the end of the hall where Security is currently located.

Ambulance Entrance: Interior Changes

A new access into the ED will be created directly across the hallway from the current Security office. The morgue will be (temporarily) transitioned into the space currently by Security. We'd like to thank the following people who are moving offices to accommodate the temporary Emergency Room entrance for ambulance arrivals.

- Infection Control: Donna Pearce and Eileen Crowe: moving to the old Pharmacy office, following completion of renovations there
- Dietary: Carol Buonamano and Alana Dolloff: moving to the former Infection Control Office
- Security office: moving to Carol and Alana's former offices
- The mail room will remain in the current location

Cafe Parking / Access (See #5 on Map)

Utility lines for our new generator building will be installed through the parking lot near Shipping /Receiving within the next week. Please drive carefully through this area as road access will be limited to one lane to accommodate this construction.
